



GLAS Traditional Farm Buildings Grant Scheme TRANCHE 3 2018 TIMELINES (ESTIMATED)

Mid October 2017	2018 GLAS Traditional Farm Buildings Grant Scheme announced
Mid October 2017	Heritage Council advertises scheme and invites applications
November 2017	Applicant completes form and submits hard copy application along with other relevant information to Heritage Council by confirmed deadline
End December 2017	Acknowledgment letters issued
January 2018	Heritage Council screens and assesses all eligible applications using specified criteria
February 2018	Heritage Council notifies all applicants of decision
March 2018	Information seminar held for successful applicants
May/June 2018	Conservation specification submitted for prior agreement
June/July 2018	Grantee ensures bat/bird survey (where required) is carried out.
September/October 2018	Grantee submits interim report to Heritage Council
September/October 2018	Possible Interim Inspection by Heritage Council
September /October 2018	Heritage Council sends grantee checklist for grant drawdown.
October 2018	Grantee completes work and submits final documentation to Heritage Council
October/November 2018	Final Inspection by Heritage Council. Snagging to be carried out if needed.
November 2018	Heritage Council certifies projects to Department of Agriculture, Food & the Marine for payment
November/December 2018	Grantee paid grant by Department of Agriculture, Food & the Marine
