



GLAS Traditional Farm Buildings Grant Scheme TRANCHE 2 2017 TIMELINES

Mid October 2016	2017 GLAS Traditional Farm Buildings Grant Scheme announced
Mid October 2016	Heritage Council advertises scheme and invites applications
Mid November 2016	Applicant completes form and submits hard copy application along with other relevant information to Heritage Council by confirmed deadline
End December 2016	Acknowledgment letters issued
January 2017	Heritage Council screens and assesses all eligible applications using specified criteria
Mid February 2017	Heritage Council notifies all applicants of decision
March/April 2017	Successful applicants (grantees) return acceptance form and information. Grantee submits conservation specification for prior agreement
May/June 2017	Prior Inspection by Heritage Council.
June/July 2017	Grantee ensures bat/bird survey (where required) is carried out
September 2017	Grantee submits interim report to Heritage Council
September 2017	Possible Interim Inspection by Heritage Council
September 2017	Heritage Council sends grantee checklist for grant drawdown.
October 2017	Grantee completes work and submits final documentation to Heritage Council
October/November 2017	Final Inspection by Heritage Council. Snagging to be carried out if needed.
November 2017	Heritage Council certifies projects to Department of Agriculture, Food & the Marine for payment
November/December 2017	Grantee paid grant by Department of Agriculture, Food & the Marine
